

Auto biography of Dr. Fariba Eslamian

I was born in Tabriz/Iran in 1975. I finished my high school in Parvin(Tohid) school in 1993 and straight entered the medicine faculty of Tabriz university of medical sciences in the same year. I graduated as general physician at September 2000. I finished my professional course in Physical medicine and rehabilitation (PM&R) specialty after 3-year period at 2005 and earned the number one award for first rank in the National Board certification Examination of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation in Tehran, Iran, September 2005. After that I directly started to work with assistant professor degree in Tabriz University of medical sciences in the same year.
